

## **Research Project Guidelines**

The students take up the research projects during the final year. The research projects are part of the prescribed syllabus and is therefore mandatory for the students during the course of the programme. The research supervisors are allotted to the students on the first day of the semester.

### **Guidelines for the Supervisor**

- The HOD and the Dean of the School will allot the supervisor to the students
- The supervisor will help the student with:
  - Selection of the topic
  - Finalizing the research methodology
  - The data collection
  - The data analysis
  - The report compilation
- The supervisor will monitor the progress of the student and will record the assessment of the student timely.
- The students need to be maintain all the ethical standards while undertaking the research project.
- The students must regularly apprise the supervisor about the research progress.
- In case of any problem with the topic taken up for the research project, the student must inform the supervisor. Any change in topic after the finalization will only be allowed on the behest of the supervisor.
- The students must submit the final research report in the prescribed format or the format suggested by the supervisor.

### **Evaluation and Assessment**

- The students will be continuously evaluated on the basis of the submission of the deadline based tasks allotted to the student by the supervisor.
- The criteria for evaluation will be:
  - Novelty
  - Ethical standards maintained
  - Meeting the deadlines
  - The structure of the final report
