





## 9th September 2021 DME CINE TREASER

Cine Treasures, the Film Appreciation Society of Delhi Metropolitan Education, organized an interactive event 'Heroes on Screen, An objective look at the portrayal of Armed Forces with the support of the Faculty Conveners, Ms. Manmeet Kaur and Ms. Shanu Jain. The event was arranged to learn about the framework and making of patriotic movies, showcasing the major role of the army. The Guest Speaker, Mr. Pankaj Rakesh (Seasoned Filmmaker, Photographer, and Media Educator, New Delhi) who has been working in the field of Moviemaking for three decades shared his experience and insights with the audience.
