On November 25, 2022 at 3 p.m., DME Cine Treasures, the Film Appreciation society of Delhi Metropolitan Education, hosted a movie screening session of the movie: "That Day after Every day", starring Radhika Apte with a total of 8 participants in debate. The film screening was preceded by a Debate competition on the topic, "Genderization of Profession: Paradigm of Casual Sexism". The judges were Dr Raveena Bhargava, Assistant Professor, DME Law School, Ms Shirly Rex, Assistant Professor, DME Management School, and Ms Sukriti Arora, Assistant Professor, DME Media School.

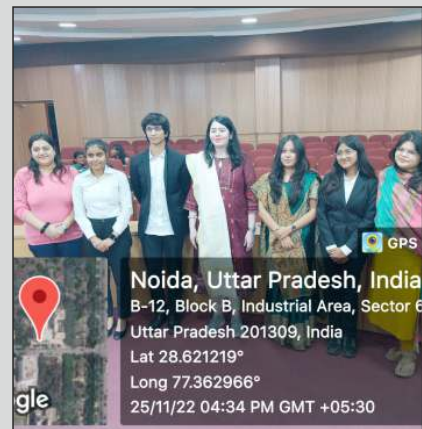
Ms Avantika Banerjee did a brief discussion on the topic before starting with the debate speeches of the students. She explained, "Casual sexism consists of generalized



sexist statements or attitudes, coarse language, and a threatening or demeaning work environment as a whole." Prachi Kushwaha, BALLB 2nd Year, the winner of the debate, spoke against the motion and discussed a case study of Hotel Priya vs the State of Maharashtra, which was about Gender Cap. Tanya Singh BALLB, 1st Year, the first runner-up, spoke against the motion and mentioned, "it's time for the society to understand that profession is not something related to gender." Rishabh Chaturvedi, BBA LLB 1st Year, the second runner-up, in for the motion speech discussed the recent Rishiraj Singh, Kerala Excise Commissioner case where he said the man who stares at a woman for more than 14 seconds continuously should be slapped with a sexual harassment suit and jailed. He added, "is this what justice at the workplace is, and is a stopwatch the measuring tool to tell what sexual harassment is?" The screening and debate session concluded with remarks from Ms Arora, Judge, who commented, "Casual Sexism at the workplace is not just female-centric but also observed for males in certain professions." Dr Bhargava, another judge, gave her views on prejudice in society about particular gender, creating discrimination and adding barriers to success in various arenas. Ms Rex, another judge, gave her valuable comments on how to debate professionally and present any concrete views on strongly opinionated topics.

The event would not have been possible without the support of the Faculty Convener of the society, Dr Manmeet Kaur, Associate Professor, Media School, and Ms Avantika Banerjee, Assistant Professor, Law School and our Cultural Cell Head Ms. Navjot Suri.
