




From the desk of Dean


NATIONAL CONFERENCE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND LAW: A CLOSE INTERFACE







Prof. (Dr.) Balraj Chauhan, referred to the Kalimath committee report and highlighting the importance of the role of a victim within the criminal justice system.





International Conference



Among the various conferences and seminars that DME Media School organizes on regular intervals, **ICAN** has emerged as a brand in just one year.

The key concept of organizing this international conference is to give a platform to researchers, academicians and students to present their research work, interact with people from the industry and to share new thoughts for the betterment of mankind.

DME Media School has successfully organised two editions of ICAN in 2018. While the first edition saw participation of researchers from countries like Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka and UK, the second edition raised the stakes when DME joined hands with School of Communication and Creative Arts, Deakin University, Australia for the conference.



Delhi Metropolitan Education (DME) reserved its place in the galaxy of prestigious institutions of India by organising first of its kind international conference in New Delhi and Noida in November, 2018. The participation of more than five hundred academicians, researchers, media professionals and students of bachelors, master and PhD programme in 8 technical sessions, 3 plenary sessions, 3 workshops, inaugural and opening sessions, valedictory session along with an evening of music and dance might envy any emerging educational institution.

ICAN² 2018 was endorsed by **Govt. of India** when **Mr Satya Pal Singh,** Minister of State for Human Resource Development, lauded the efforts of DME in brining Australia closer to India in the field of academics and research. Mr. Singh inaugurated the conference as Chief Guest at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi on November 16, 2018.

This international conference **Indian Cinema** and **Alternate Networks- ICAN**² 2018 was jointly organised by DME Media School of Delhi Metropolitan Education, Noida and School of Creative Arts and Communication, **Deakin University**, Melbourne, Australia. This Indian-Australian collaboration was unique and worked excellently on the ground.



When the entire world came to a halt amid the rise of the global pandemic in 2020, DME Media School set another benchmark by organising its prestigious international conference i.e. ICAN, in the full digital mode on June 1-10, 2020. Thus, ICAN³ became the World's first 10-day digital live international conference.

With the theme of 'Issues of Community, Agenda and News', more 200 plus papers were received from four continents- Asia, Europe, America and Australia. Out of these, 141 papers by 174 authors were published in six books with ISBN. More than 200 scholars from 55 universities and 18 colleges made 158 presentations in 14 technical sessions. More than 50 eminent persons from academics and industry participated in 3 Master Classes, 3 Panel Discussion, 3 Plenary and 2 Special sessions.

DME Media School in collaboration with School of Communication and Creative Arts, Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia organised the International Conference, ICAN4, with the theme Information Communication and Artificial Networks. The conference lasted for 10 days, i.e. from July 1 to July 10 in the virtual mode. The conference received support from Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR).

ICAN4 witnessed participation of about 60 eminent scholars from five continents and 11 countries, namely India, South Korea, Malaysia, Singapore, Bangladesh, USA, Mexico, France, Italy, Australia and Ghana. The conference received abstracts and research presentations of more than 100 media educators and researchers There were 36 live sessions scheduled including 9 technical sessions, 3 Workshops, 7 Panel Discussions, 3 special sessions and 10 Master Classes. All the 9 technical sessions were chaired and co-chaired by women scholars representing different states of the country.


Workplace Digitalisation: Challenges, Opportunities & Future Trends

Career Guidance Webinar Series



Short term Industry Ready Training Program



Internships and Placements

Student Placement is a 'real' work experience gained within a 'real' working environment that complements the student's degree qualification and provides mutual benefit to both the employer and the student.

Placement can fall into a variety of names including 'Job', 'Campus Placement', 'off campus Placement', 'Placement Semester', 'Semester in Industry', and probably a few more having the same meaning.

DMEs' objective of campus placements is to identify talented and qualified professionals before they complete their education. It provides employment opportunities to students who are pursuing or in the final stage of completing their courses. Research shows that employers recruit graduates with the right set of Knowledge, Skills & Attitude.

Campus drives are conducted at the college / at the corporate premises / a common place to provide opportunities to students pursuing or in the stage of completing the course. During a campus drive, the corporate select students depending on their performance in written tests, Group Discussions & Personal Interviews.

Advantages of "Campus Recruitment Drives" for the students include Jobs at their doorstep, Saving in terms of "Search Costs", Savings in terms of "Application Cost" and savings in terms of "Travel cost". On the other hand, advantages for the recruiters include getting a student pool offering a wide choice at a single point, savings in terms of "Advertisement Cost" and dealing with one college rather than large number of students. All seats available at DME for all courses have been full over the last years. Prospective candidates are advised to be alert during the admissions process.

DME admits students on the basis of the result of the Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by the GGSIP University for the BA (JMC) and BBA courses. For Law, the admissions will be on the basis of the CLAT score of the candidates. However, this may be subject to change and candidates are advised to keep checking https://ipu.ac.in to stay updated.

90% of the admissions are done through University Counselling and 10% seats are available for Management Quota. The criteria for admission through Management Quota, is strictly merit based (results of the qualifying exam as specified by the University and an interview).

85% of the seats available in counselling are reserved for Delhi Category students.

Candidate can fill in the online application form for the admission to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University at the university website (**www.ipu.ac.in**).

For Management Quota seats, candidates can apply at **info@dme.ac.in** or in person at the campus once the admissions process commences and is notified.
