Water conservation at the campus

Water is a precious natural national resource with almost fixed quantum of availability. Out of all the water available, only three percent is fresh water. Therefore, it is essential to use this water wisely and carefully. However, we have been doing the opposite of this till now. Every day, we keep exploiting water for a variety of purposes. In addition to that, we also keep polluting it day in and day out. The effluents from industries and sewage discharges are dispersed into our water bodies directly.

Conservation of Water refers to **preserving, controlling and developing water resources, both surface water and groundwater, and preventing water pollution.**

Water conservation is known as using water efficiently to reduce unnecessary water usage and avoid its wastage.

Hence for the purpose of conservation of water the Institution has taken several measures. Some of which are pointed below:

1. The Institution promotes the use of water discharged from the Air Conditioners, water coolers for mopping purposes. For the same, the Institution has kept a separate water container where in the water from the Air Conditioners, water coolers are collected and later used for mopping and cleaning purposes.
2. Rain water is a very important source of water. Rainwater harvesting has many benefits but the main one is that it is a sustainable water management. Hence for conservation of the same the institution has several rainwater pits throughout the campus.
3. The institution uses an alarm system in the water tanks to stop overflowing of water.
4. The Institution conducts regular awareness drives to create awareness to save water amongst students as well as faculty members.
5. DME promotes the policy of saving water. For the same, water coolers have been installed on each floor for the easy access of students.

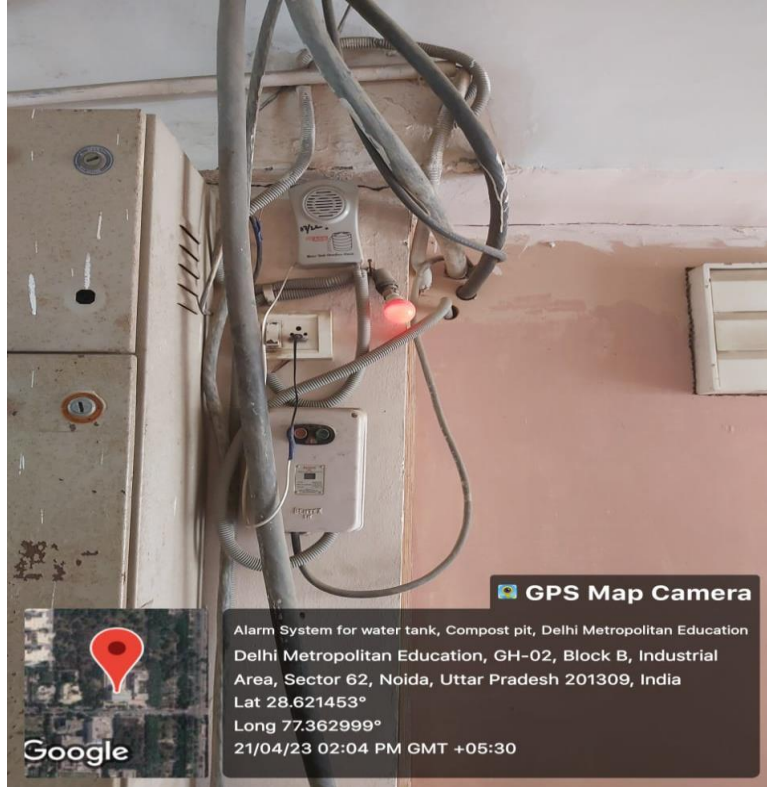
