

Research Promotion Policy

Objective: Delhi Metropolitan Education strongly emphasizes research and development amongst its students and faculty members. DME is committed to contributing to academia, society and the nation at large by promoting interdisciplinary research, critical thinking, and innovation. This policy serves as a framework for research activities and ensures the conduct of research in an accountable and ethical manner for advancing knowledge and developing novel ideas.

Scope: This policy applies to all DME schools, faculty members, staff, and students undertaking any research publications/projects. This research policy shall act as the basis of all the research-related activities in DME.

Goals:

- 1. To integrate research-oriented learning across all programmes
- To strengthen the academic and research network through national and international collaborations
- 3. To ensure a facilitating environment for the conduct of interdisciplinary, and quality research
- 4. To ensure high levels of academic integrity and ethical research
- To promote research on contemporary and relevant areas in Management, Law and Media

Research Cell, DME:

The Research Cell at DME is constituted to foster an environment of research and innovation. The Cell strives relentlessly towards contributing and disseminating knowledge, providing faculty members and student fraternity opportunities for research publications, and organizing research-oriented events. It is an institutional body for facilitating, mobilizing, and monitoring all research-based activities.

- Vision: To develop and strengthen the research ecosystem that fosters innovation through collaborative and ethical conduct.
- Mission: To undertake research-based activities/projects/ teaching pedagogies and add value to the existing academic and practical knowledge. To promote innovationbased culture, creative thinking, problem-solving and outcome-based research.

Constitution of the Research Cell:

- The Research Cell is a nodal-institutional body led by the Head of the Research Cell and comprises Faculty members from all three schools.
- Under its aegis, Research Centres focusing on relevant disciplines and subject areas are to be constituted in the field of Intellectual Property Rights, Gender Studies, Sustainability, Entrepreneurship, Innovations in Media, Constitutional Law, Criminal Law, Environment Law, and Human Rights.
- Every faculty member is to be a part of one Research Centre as per their interest and area
 of expertise. Research Centres may have their own student body. Collaboration amongst
 the research centres for conducting activities and undertaking publications is encouraged.
- Student Body of Research Cell led by Student Convenors and members from all the three schools

Scope of Activities under Research Cell

- 1. To publish books and in-house research journals with good indexing and a reputed Editorial Board.
- To motivate the faculty members and students to publish research papers, book chapters, case reviews and edited books.
- To encourage faculty members to pursue collaborative research projects with reputed Universities (national and international), Government and private organizations.
- 4. To regularly conduct research-oriented workshops, conferences, and Faculty Development Programmes.
- 5. To provide continued and practical support for pursuing research activities in contemporary and relevant research areas.

Intellectual Property Rights

The submissions made to and accepted for publication in DME Journals/Books therein shall be the intellectual property of DME and will be governed by the IPR policy of DME.

• The research papers/publications/projects undertaken by faculty members or students outside DME shall be the Intellectual Property of the scholar.
