SPECTRUM, the art society of Delhi Metropolitan Education College, did a three-day cultural artwork from April 10, 2023, to April 12, 2023, with the theme of LGBTQ+ inclusivity. The event aimed to promote the acceptance and celebration of the LGBTQ+ community and its members through artistic expression. The artwork was done on three walls, each with its unique message.

The first wall featured a heart-shaped handprint with various quotes written inside it. The handprint symbolized the unity and love between the LGBTQ+ community and its allies. The quotes written inside the handprint were inspirational and inclusive, emphasizing the importance of acceptance and equality. Some of the quotes written inside the heart-shaped handprint were:
