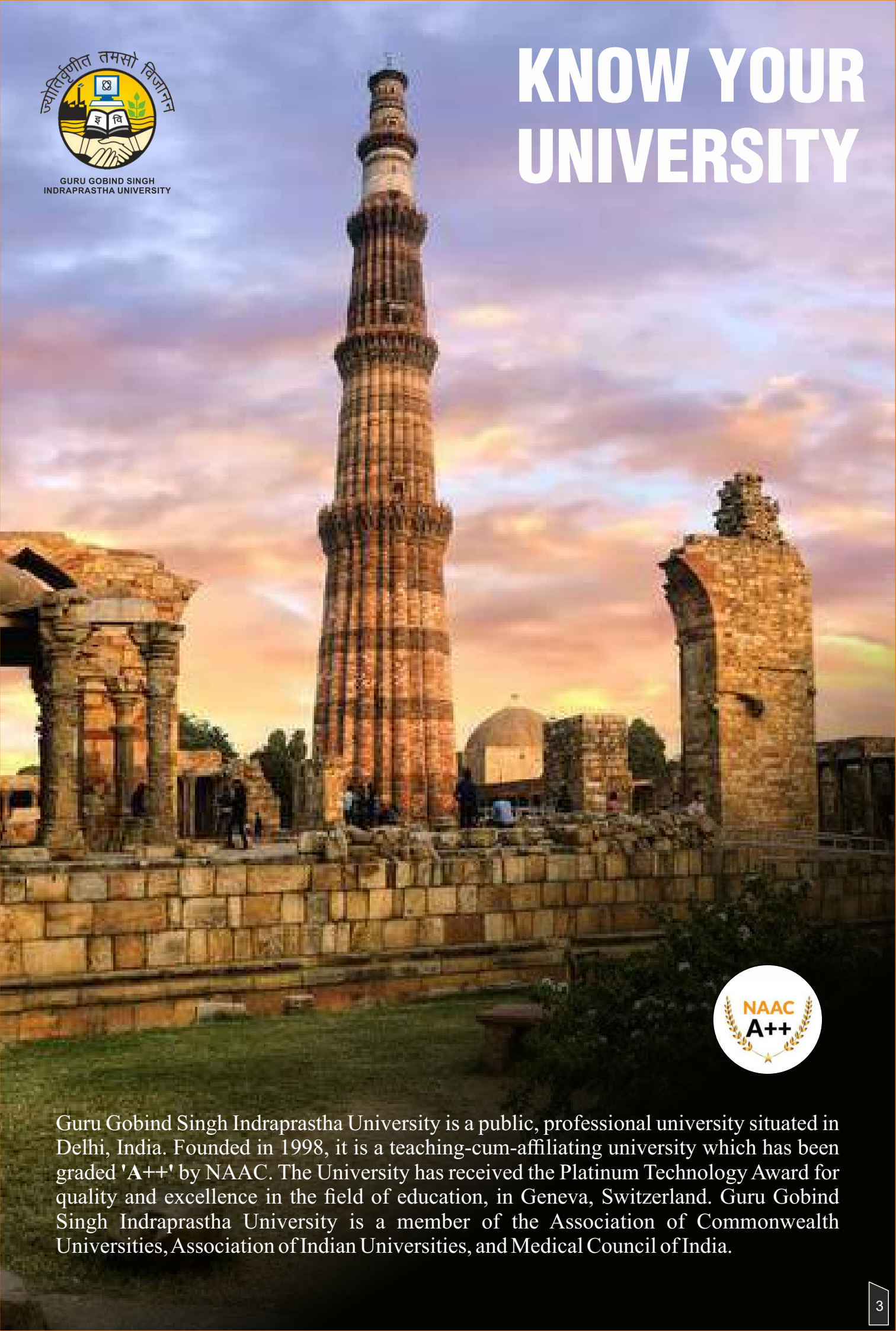

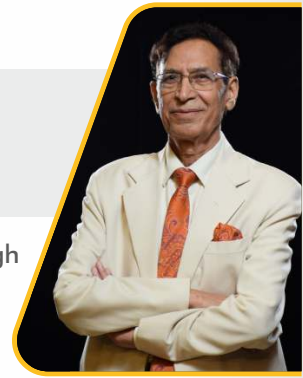

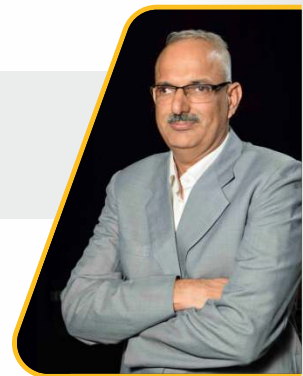

RECENT ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

OVERVIEW

DME Media School facilitates industry training of students during summer internships & also organizes interactions by inviting eminent people from the industry. This training conducted through various interactions such as conferences, webinars etc., helps students in acquiring necessary practical skills and prepares them for the industry.

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES

India and Changing Aspects of News: The aim was to interact with people from the industry and to share new thoughts for the betterment of mankind.

DME Media School had successfully organised two editions of ICAN in 2018. While the first edition saw participation of researchers from countries like Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka and UK, the second edition raised the stakes when DME joined hands with School of Communication and Creative Arts, Deakin University, Australia for the conference.

Indian Cinema and Alternate Networks: This conference jointly organised by DME Media School and School of Creative Arts and Communication, Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia saw a participation of more than five hundred academicians, researchers, media professionals and students of bachelors, master and PhD programmes.

This conference was endorsed by Govt. of India when Mr Satya Pal Singh, Minister of State for Human Resource Development, lauded the efforts of DME in brining Australia closer to India in the field of academics and research.

Issues of Community, Agenda and News: This conference was the World's first 10-day digital live international conference which saw a participation of over 200 plus papers . 55 universities and 18 colleges made 158 presentations in 14 technical sessions. More than 50 eminent persons from academics and industry participated in 3 Master Classes, 3 Panel Discussion, 3 Plenary and 2 Special sessions.

Information Communication and Artificial Networks: This conference conducted by DME Media School in collaboration with School of Communication and Creative Arts, Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia was also a 10 day virtual conference and received immense support from Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR).

IAMCR women of substance discusses Gendered Media Space: International Association for Media and Communication Research in association with Media School of Delhi Metropolitan Education organised a Panel Discussion on 'Gendered Media Space: Shattering the Glass Screen'.

There were 36 live sessions scheduled including 9 technical sessions, 3 Workshops, 7 Panel Discussions, 3 special sessions and 10 Master Classes. All the 9 technical sessions were chaired and co-chaired by women scholars representing different states of the country.

Inclusivity, Convergence, and Alternative Negotiations: This conference was a 7-day Hybrid International Conference which witnessed a galaxy of prominent academicians and industry professionals from India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Australia,



USA and other countries. The conference organized in collaboration with Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia. All the sessions were chaired by eminent industry experts and renowned academicians.

Identity, Culture, Agenda Driven, Newscast: This conference was a Hybrid International Conference that was conducted in a staggered format with sessions being conducted in 5 different venues including Delhi Metropolitan Education, Manavrachna International University, IAMR Group of Institutions, Makhanlal Chaturvedi National university of Journalism and Communication, Bhopal and Daffodil University, Dhaka, Bangladesh. The conference was organized in collaboration with Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia. All the sessions were chaired by eminent industry experts and renowned academicians.

OTHER EVENTS

CIFFI: DME Media School in association with Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia annually organises CIFFI (**CINEASTE International Film Festival of India**) to promote cross culture films and bring together artistically inclined minds.

The festival features organizations like **Vigyan Prasar, Department of Science & Technology, Government of India, Delhi International Film Festival, WE CARE film festival, University Film Club AMU, Indian Academy of Shorts & Aquarius Productions, Adamas University, Cover Drive Productions, Kidz Cinema 2020, CMS Vatavaran, Indian Documentary Producers' Association, Indian Academy of Shorts, and New Delhi Film Foundation.**

CIFFI 2022 on Cinema 'n Covid-19 impact, the seven-day mega event was the **World's first Hybrid International Film Festival** by educational institutions.

VRITIKA: Vritika- Convention of Media Students provides a 3 day platform to media students across the country to deliberate and discuss relevant, contemporary media issues with their peers and experts.

Vritika provides the participants an opportunity to explore their potential through Creative writing, News writing, Debate, Photography, Media Quiz, Anchor Hunt, Radio Jingle, RJ Hunt,

TRAINING OF TRAINERS: A 7 day Workshop on Strengthening a Gender Sensitive Media Environment in Maldives conducted by DME and AWA under the aegis of IPDC-UNESCO.

The participants were journalists from the Maldives who have been there and the aim of this workshop was to propose a policy intervention and sensitize practicing journalists of Maldives about different perspectives of Gender.

MEDIA LITERACY SERIES WITH ADAMAS UNIVERSITY:

DME, Noida and Adamas University Kolkata have created a 3 week online course that aims to create a better society and vigilant youth, with an intense Media Literacy course for school students. The objective was to impart essential skills amongst students so that instead of being passive receivers, they become active in the media content creation and comprehension process.



DME TV

DME operates its YouTube channel DME TV to provide its students a platform to hone their reporting, anchoring and production skills and prepare them thoroughly for the industry by engaging in constructive learning and getting acquainted with the professional environment.

DME TV has its own production facility and has a number of active programmes in its basket like DME UNO, a daily dose of contemporary information; DME Sport, the sport bulletin of DME; DME Round Up, campus news programme; DME Dialogue, an interview based programme; DME Students Corner, interview platform of eminent guests by students; DME Flashlight, featuring community connect initiatives and many more.

Special lectures, workshops or seminars conducted by leading personalities from academics and industry are captured in DME Discourse, again a student's produced programme.



MEDIA RESEARCH

Research and Innovation in Media (RIM), the research wing of the DME Media School focuses at creating value and innovation in the field of mass media through the best research practices.

RIM also organized a three-day workshop on Qualitative Research Methods with ace researcher Prof. (Dr.) Dayanand Sansanwal as the key resource person.

RIM also undertook a project on role of women in the ongoing protests and their contribution in social change. This wing is currently working on a documentary film with personal interviews of eminent scholars, social workers and experts as part of the project.



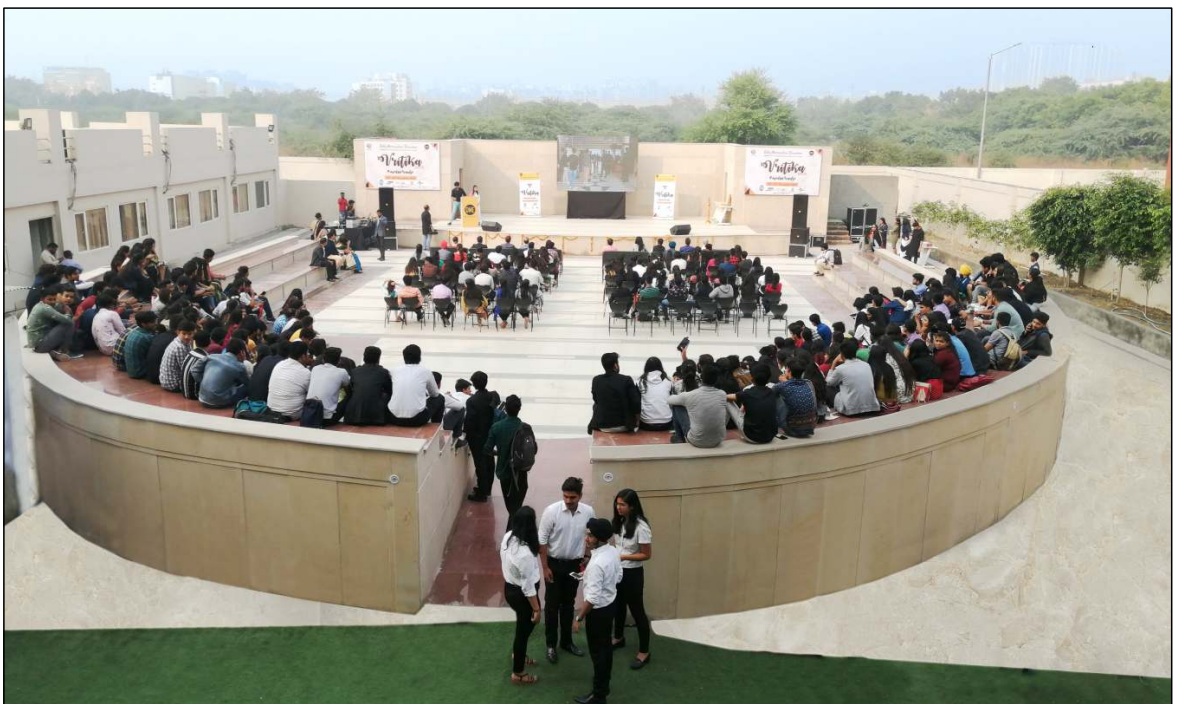

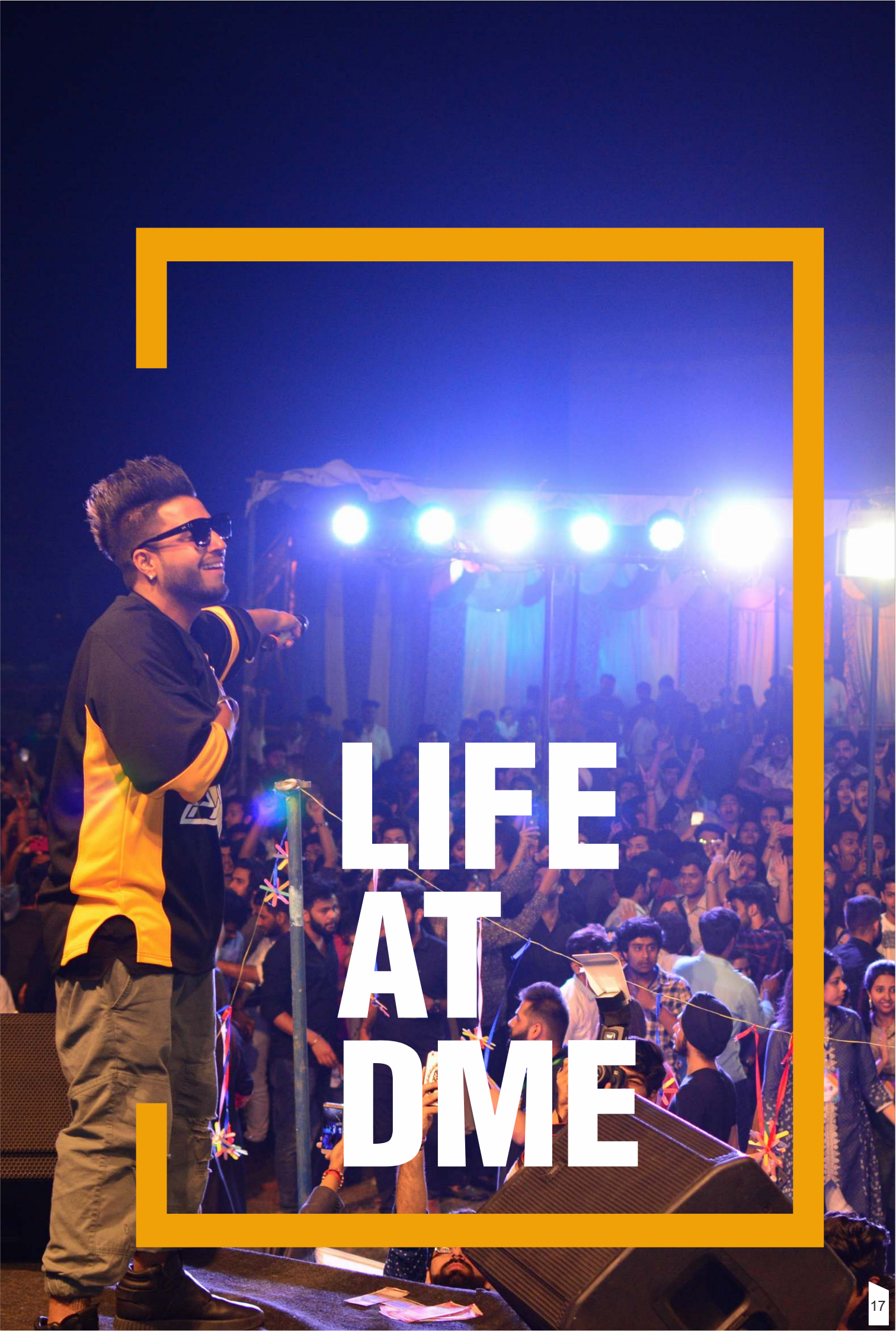

ADMISSIONS

All seats available at DME for all courses have been full over the last years. Prospective candidates are advised to be alert during the admissions process. DME admits students on the basis of the result of the Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by the GGSIP University or CUET for the BA (JMC) and BBA courses. For Law, the admissions will be on the basis of the CLAT UG score of the candidates or their CUET score. Admission in LL.M shall be taken on the basis of score in CLAT PG.
